Champlin Park High School is located northwest of the Minneapolis-St. Paul metropolitan area and serves students in the communities of Champlin, Brooklyn Park, Brooklyn Center, and Dayton.

Champlin Park, one of five high schools in the Anoka-Hennepin School District, graduated its first class in 1993. The district also has six middle schools, twenty-eight elementary schools and two kindergarten centers with a total enrollment of 40,500. The student population at Champlin Park High School is approximately 3,070 in grades 9 through 12.

The curriculum at Champlin Park is comprehensive and includes courses of study for college-bound students as well as for students planning to enter technical colleges, military, or employment. To meet the diverse needs of students, the curriculum includes Advanced Placement and Honors courses, College in the Schools, and Internship programs.

Champlin Park International Baccalaureate Diploma Program

Champlin Park was authorized to begin the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program in May 2006. The 2006/7 school year was the first year of offering IB classes with junior students.

Students may apply to transfer to Champlin Park High as anticipated IB diploma candidates. Application for transfer must be done between December 1st and January 15th during the student's sophomore year.
