DEMOGRAPHICS:

Lincoln Center Elementary is a large and diverse St Paul suburban school with 941 students, kindergarten through sixth grade. Per grade level, Lincoln has as many as seven sections and as few as four. Of our 941 students 39.1% receive free or reduced lunch. A breakdown of Lincoln Center's diverse student body is as follows: 1.4% Native American, 2.3% Asian, 9.8% Black, 19.7% Hispanic, and 66.8% White.

SPECIFICS OF THE PYP:

Lincoln Center offers a full-school program with six PYP units of inquiry explored at each grade level including an exciting sixth grade exhibition. Lincoln offers Spanish, Physical Education, Music, and Art to all students. Each of the previous has developed comprehensive integration of the PYP units of inquiry.
